I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiances and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Sweden the King of Norway, of which I have heretofore been a citizen (and that I further renounce the same in order of nobility, which I hold heretofore held); that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America, against all enemies, foreign and domestic, and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER
