I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Nicholas II the Emperor of Russia, of which I have heretofore been a subject (and that I further renounce the title of Baron (and that I have heretofore borne); that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic, and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER

It is further ordered, upon consideration of the petition of the said John Haglund, that his name be, and hereby is, changed to Olaf Laurits Molnes under authority of the provisions of section 8 of an act entitled "An Act to Establish a Bureau of Investigation and Naturalization, and to provide for a uniform rule for the naturalization of aliens throughout the United States," approved June 30, 1906.

My full name is Olaf Laurits Molnes, of Seattle, Washington, D.C.

My place of birth is Oslo, Republic of Sweden, of Sweden, in the Western District Court of Oslo County, Norway.
I was born on the 10th day of August, 1870, at Oslo, Norway.
I emigrated to the United States from Oslo, Norway, on or about the 15th day of August, 1892, and arrived at the port of Seattle, Washington, on the 10th day of December, 1892.
I passed my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 10th day of December, 1892, at Seattle, in the Western District Court of Seattle County, Washington.
I am single. My wife's name is Leahy, and her name is Leahy.
I was born on the 10th day of August, 1870, at Oslo, Norway, and now reside at Seattle, Wash.

I am not a dual citizen in or against to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disloyalty to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Hakon VII King of Norway, of which at this time I am a citizen, and so my intention to renounce the United States.
I am able to read the English language.
I have resided continuously in the United States of America for a term of five years at the immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 10th day of August, 1892, and in the Western District Court of Seattle, for one year of that said preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 10th day of November, 1922.
I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. I made no petition for citizenship to any court.
